

Parks & Open Space Update

The warm weather is here and the City of Hoboken is very excited to offer Hoboken residents some great park renovations to enjoy! Check our website (www.hobokennj.gov) and follow us on twitter (www.twitter.com/cityofhoboken) and facebook (www.facebook.com/hoboken) for the latest information.

Stevens Park & Little League Field: As soon as the new turf was down, the first batter was up! Next projects to bring home include batting cages, new playground equipment and a renovated dog run (Thanks to the County for the grant to returf).



Elysian Park: Thanks to a \$600,000 grant from Green Acres, we look forward to restoring this beautiful park. Construction starts this summer, but will be done in phases so the park can remain open.

Church Square Park: This lively park is even more active than ever with new equipment that can also be enjoyed by our older children. Phase II will include new additions for our toddlers, outdoor ping pong tables, new restrooms and a lot more!



1600 Park & Hoboken Cove: This park is very close to being finished, but we want to make sure that we get it right so no one gets hurt due to soil settlement problems in the future. Better safe than sorry is our philosophy, so additional testing will be done to fully analyze settlement issues and avoid costly returfing in the future. We too cannot wait to shortly bring Hoboken a new multi-use field, lighting, bleachers, leaning rails, a dog run, restrooms, bike racks, a slide hill, and viewing mound!

Sinatra Park: It has been a long road, but those shipworms don't have a chance with the new field that is being built the way it should have been the first time years ago! Rebuilding stronger than ever is our commitment! The waterfront soccer field and Castle Point Park on are on track for late summer completion.



Jackson St Park (120 Jackson St), **Jefferson Park** (1st & Jefferson), **Madison St Park** and **Legion Park** (1225 Willow Ave): We hope everyone is having fun at these newly renovated playgrounds. Phase II of the renovations are planned for Legion Park.

Pier A Park: Sub-surface structural repairs are scheduled pending Council approval.

Pier C Park: The repair work has been bid out and we are planning for a partial opening as early as possible this summer.

Mama Johnson Field: Everyone is loving the new smooth and springy surface at this 4th St & Jackson St field thanks to a partnership with the Hoboken Housing Authority. This will be the location for our new lacrosse program for 8-14 year olds until 1600 Park opens.

Castle Point Skate Park: Renovations and repairs have been completed for a summer of skate boarding action.

Waterfront walkway: the walkway between Hoboken and Weehawken opened in 2012. After some legal challenges, we will be auctioning off the climate change boat left by the delinquent owner!

Open Space Acquisition

Nothing comes easy in Hoboken, but we are forging ahead with jumping every legal hurdle to bring our City more open space. Unfortunately we are millions of dollars apart on the price for the purchase of Block 12, a one-acre site in Southwest Hoboken, targeted to be the first phase of a larger **Southwest Park**. We are working our way through the legal process, and



expect to own the property this year. We are also in negotiations for acquiring a one-acre site at **7th St & Jackson St** and a larger site owned by BASF at **11th St & Madison St** in Northwest Hoboken.

Hoboken Offers New Bike Share & Bike Rental Program!

Hoboken is launching the nation's first hybrid bike share and bike rental program. Similar to Corner Cars, residents will be able to reserve bikes online and use them for commuting and short trips within Hoboken. Bike rentals for Hoboken residents and visitors will be available on the waterfront near Pier A for longer recreational rides. 



ATTENTION ALL DOG OWNERS

City of Hoboken, Department of Health and Human Services

The City of Hoboken Department of Health and Human Services will be stepping up its enforcement of its Dog Enforcement Ordinance, Chapter 93 of the Code of the City of Hoboken.

Please take note of some of the laws that will be enforced.

Persons found in violation of provisions of Chapter 93 may face fines, community service, imprisonment and/or impoundment of their pet as described in §93-17 A—B of the Code of the City of Hoboken.



SECTIONS OF CHAPTER 93

93-2: All dogs of licensing age (7 months of age or possessing a permanent set of teeth) kept in Hoboken must have a current Hoboken Health Department license. The registration tag must be securely attached to the dog's collar or harness at all times.

93-15: For the purposes of urination and defecation, all dogs must be curbed.

93-16: No dog may soil, defecate or deposit any droppings or fecal matter unless said droppings or fecal matter are removed by the person controlling the dog.

93-20 A.: All dogs must be securely confined and controlled by an adequate leash, no more than six (6) feet in length.

93-20 B.: Dogs shall be permitted only upon the paved areas of the Designated Waterfront Walkway, so long as the dog is safely confined and controlled by an adequate leash no more than six (6) feet in length. No dog shall be permitted on any grass, gravel or unpaved area of the Designated Waterfront Walkway.

93-22: No dogs are permitted in any public park in the City of Hoboken except to bring directly to and directly from a city dog run, without diversion, in any public park.
