Eddie Drishti present at the meeting on behalf of the license holder. Board Secretary advised the special permit for this renewal ended in July and they did not get another one. The tax clearance was just received on August 29. License holder filed the 12 page application and fees. Board asked if the issue was just the tax clearance and whether Benny Tudino's removed alcohol from July until now. Board Secretary said yes. Board Attorney asked whether the board approved the transfer. Board Secretary advised it did not go through yet and if the transfer does not go through by May 2015 it will not go through at all. License stays cited where it is and is going from executrix to a person.

**Motion to approve the resolution/liquor license renewal** was made by Commissioner Bauman and seconded by Vice Chairman Blumenfeld and approved by all three members of the board during roll call vote.

**NEW BUSINESS**
