Dear Council Members,

I am writing to ask for your support for the lease for HoLa to rent space at the multi-service center as a contingency offer for the school. Over the weekend, Executive Director Jen Sargent informed me that HoLa is currently seeking other spaces that would potentially enable the school to locate all of their middle school students together in one location.

However, in case this space does not work out, I hope the City Council will support approving the lease with the understanding that this could be offered as a contingency space for HoLa to have as a backup option if needed. HoLa should know whether or not they will need to rent space from the City before the second reading of the ordinance would be heard, which would be at the next scheduled council meeting on August 5 if approved tonight. As previously discussed, if the Council does not move ahead with this first reading tonight and HoLa does need to rent space from the City, then a special meeting in mid-August would need to be called in order to consider the request.

On another matter, please note that our corporation council just received notice that the 604 Hudson Street zoning appeal before the City Council will not be heard tonight, as the zoning appeal has been withdrawn by the appellate attorney.
