Office of Emergency Management

Titles & Salaries

- OEM Coordinator (part time): \$8,000 (stipend, after voluntary 50% cut)
- Deputy OEM Coordinator (full time): \$117,955.28
- Deputy OEM Coordinator (part time): \$4,288.00 (stipend)
- **Total: \$130,243.28**

Summary of Operating Expenses

- Manpower/overtime
- Shelter operations
- Medical triage, etc (Mid-air helicopter collision over Hudson River and other major events)
- Medicine for displaced families
- Procurement and maintenance of emergency equipment
 - Water Buffalo(s)
 - Light towers
 - Traffic message boards
 - Manual gas pumps
 - Water, food, etc for displaced families in emergency situations
 - Portable restroom facilities

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Day to Day Operations

- Coordination of emergency operations
 - Local and multi-jurisdictional
- Provide and/or facilitate training for emergency first responders and other persons
- Ensure compliance with County, State and Federal guidelines
- Develop and maintain emergency operations plan
- Represent the City of Hoboken at regional planning meetings

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Examples of Operations

- Mid-air collision of plane and helicopter over Hudson River
- H1N1 readiness planning
- 4th of July / St. Patrick's Day Parade
- Nor'easter / Major Fire
- Natural disasters, i.e. power outages, snow storms, floods, chemical emergencies
- Representation of Hoboken on planning of ARC Tunnel project and other regional planning

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Examples of Operations con't

- City Hall Identification Cards
- Planning and oversight of City Hall security
- Surveyance of critical facilities (upon request)
- Preparation of FEMA reimbursement applications
