Free Rabies Vaccination

SATURDAY, JANUARY 7, 2012

11:00 a.m. until 2:00 p.m.

Free rabies vaccination clinic Saturday, January 7, 2012, at the Multi-Service Center. All dogs must be securely fastened with a collar and leash. Dog owners must have a 2012 Hoboken dog license which can be obtained on site.

PROOF OF RESIDENCY IS REQUIRED

Please be aware that all dogs whose rabies vaccination expires at any point in 2012 will not be issued a 2012 dog license. Rabies vaccination must be valid for the entire year. It is recommended that dogs receive vaccination every 2 years. A veterinarian from the Animal Infirmary of Hoboken will administer the vaccine. Please take advantage of this opportunity to protect yourself and your pet against rabies.

- Dogs and cats brought to the clinic **must be on a leash or in a carrier and ACCOMPANIED BY AN ADULT** who will place the animal on the examining table
- Dogs must have a 2012 Hoboken license, attached to collar or harness
- License fees: **spayed/neutered**: \$10.00 **non-spayed/neutered**: \$14.00
